

Washington State Parent Teacher Association Sets Legislative Agenda -

The Washington State Parent Teacher Association held its' 36th Annual Legislative Assembly October 24th and 25th, in Vancouver, Washington. There, Mindie Wirth and Rebecca Boss joined other delegates from across the state to debate and vote on the new platform of legislative priorities for the 2015 -2016 legislative session in support of the organizational vision of "Making every child's potential a reality." The legislative platform supports the delivery of the mission:

- PTA is a powerful voice for all children.
- PTA is a relevant resource for families, schools and communities.
- PTA is a strong advocate for the well-being and education of every child.

In all, 13 issues made the short-term platform. As a whole child advocacy association, the priority issues represent health, well-being and educational needs of the children of Washington State.

- 2. Create Positive School Climates Through Social Emotional Learning
- 3. Increasing Capital Funding
- 4. Increased Access to Higher Education


Join us for Focus Day, January 19, 2015!


We intend that any and all changes meet one or more of the following criteria to be included in the draft bylaws. The proposed change should:
